


Lesson 3- Jobs in the Virtual Career Fair



Event Lobby

After entering the Event Lobby, you can navigate to other parts of the platform, which are displayed in the green headings at the top of the platform...

- virtual platform! Access the Scavenger Hunt by clicking on the icon from the green main header and see how many lightbulbs you can find!








Exhibit Hall

You can visit the auditorium throughout the day to watch webinars on a variety of topics. These webinars will be available to play on demand. Visit the Auditorium to see which webinars are available.








